

**Temporary Road Closure Order  
Town Police Clauses Act 1847**

IN ACCORDANCE with Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, which section gives Wiltshire Council ("the Council") the power to make an Order for roads within its administrative area to be closed temporarily to all vehicular traffic (and for alternative routes to be observed) for the purposes of preventing obstruction.

The Council **HEREBY ORDERS**

On: **Monday 27<sup>th</sup> August 2018** between the hours of **08.00** and **18.00**

Purpose: **Lacock Village Fair**

That the following roads and streets in the parish of **Lacock** are to be closed (save in case of emergency) to all vehicular traffic:

- a) **High Street**; from its junction with West Street / Melksham Road to its junction with East Street;
- b) **High Street (also known as Abbey Road)**; from its junction with East Street to its junction with Hither Way.

Nothing in this Order shall prevent vehicles from proceeding in the said lengths of road when being used in connection with the event stated above.

AND it is also hereby ordered that appropriately sign posted diversionary routes will be in place throughout the period of closure.
