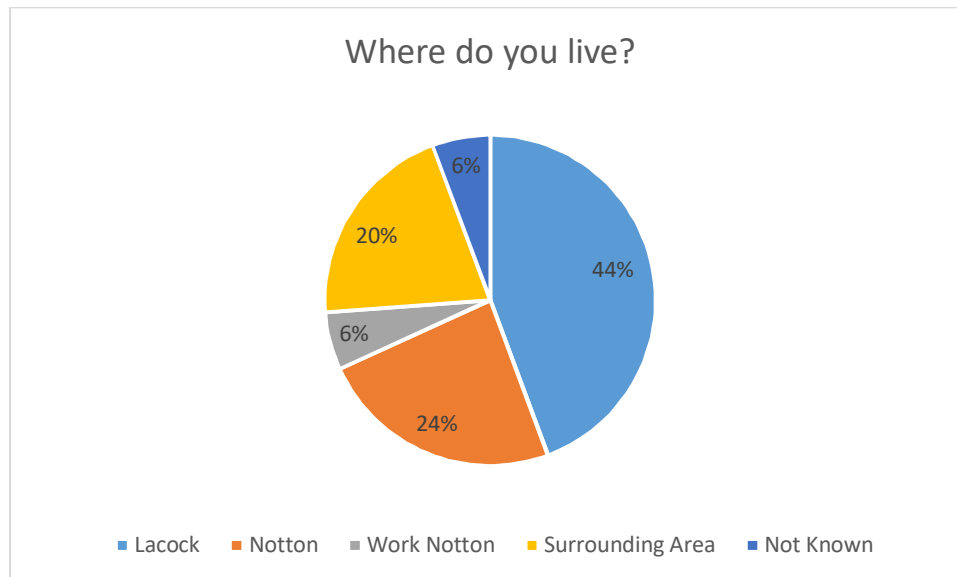

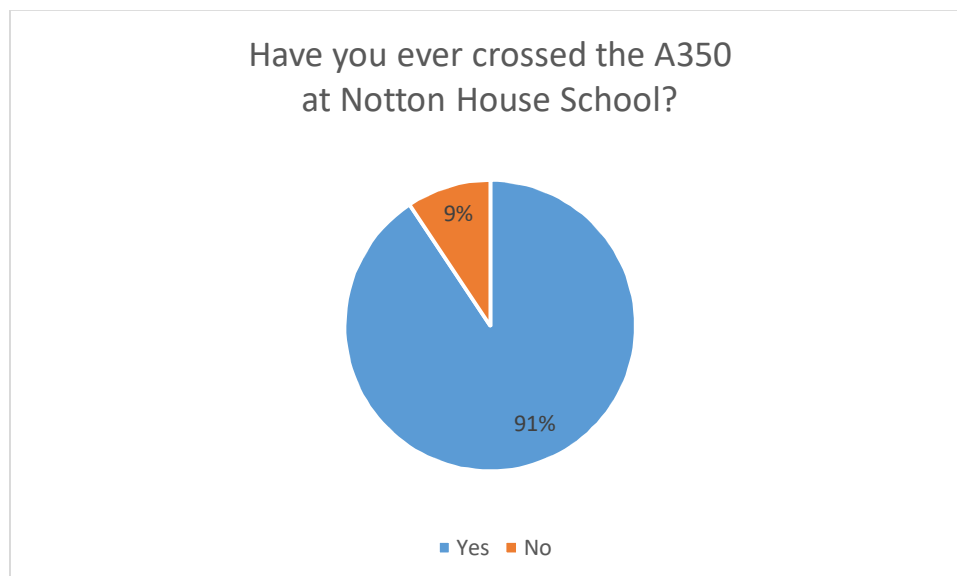
### Where Respondents Live

Responses: 88



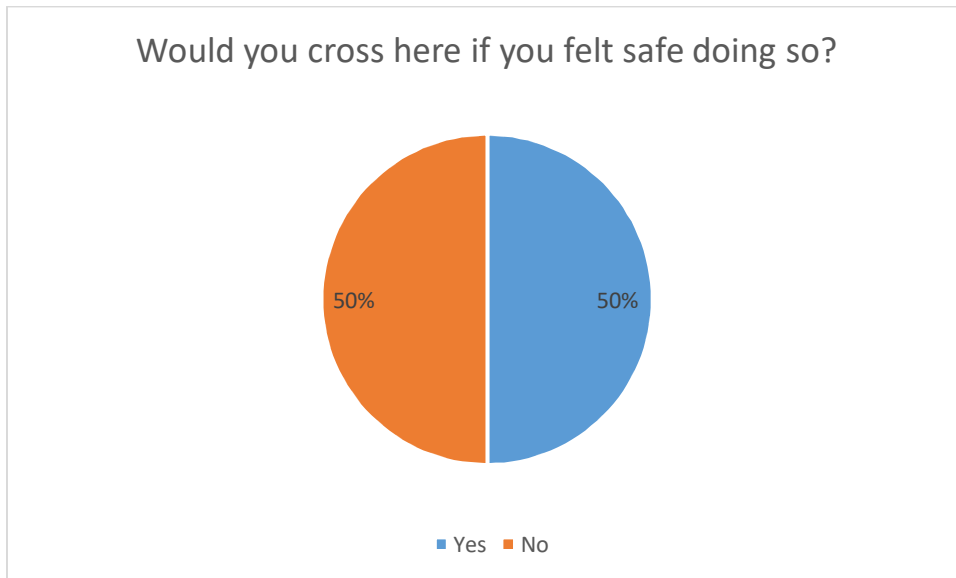
### Pedestrians, Cyclists etc. Crossing A350

Responses: 96



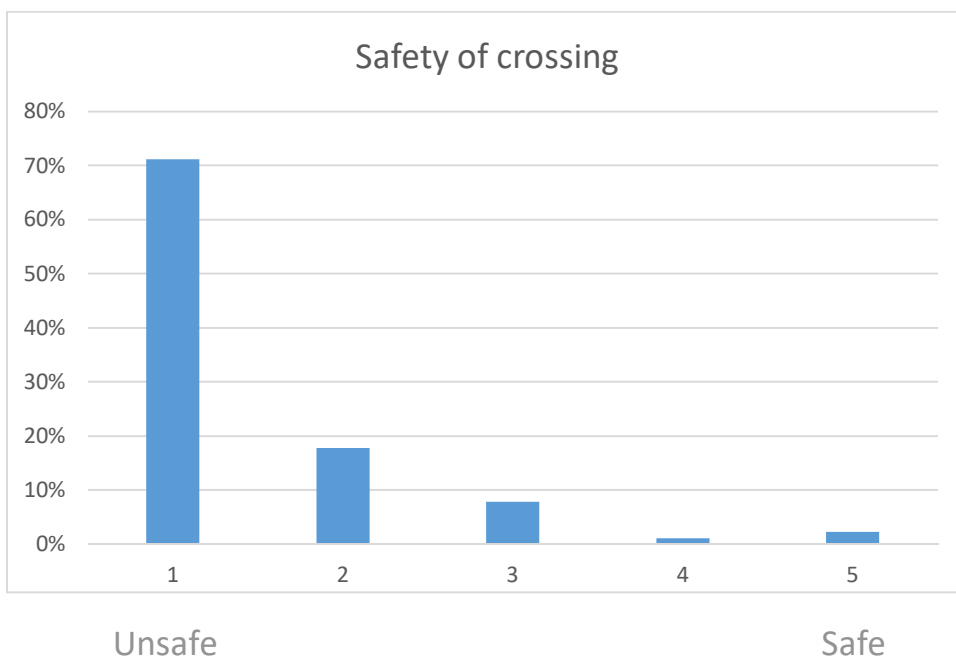
### Might you use it in the future?

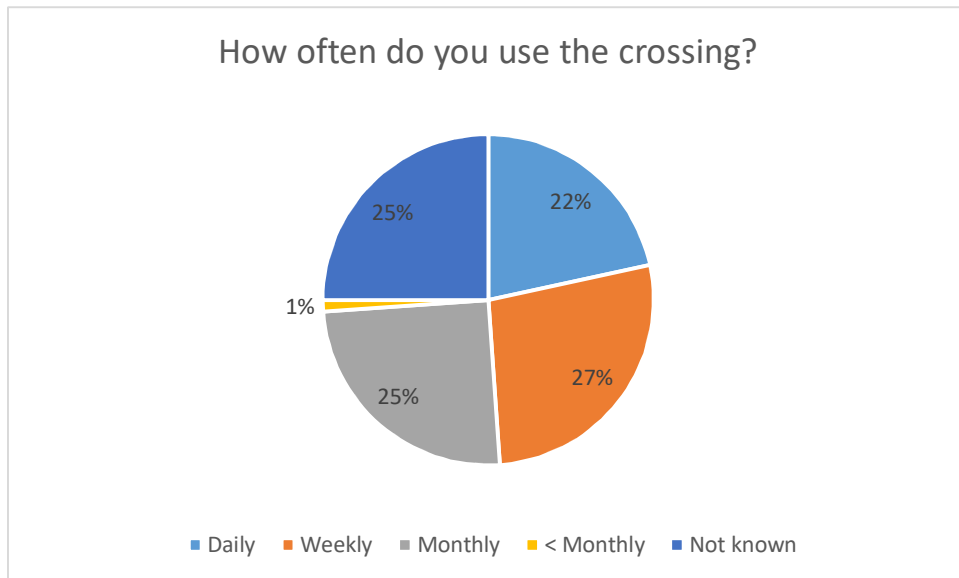
### Your opinion of safety crossing A350 here

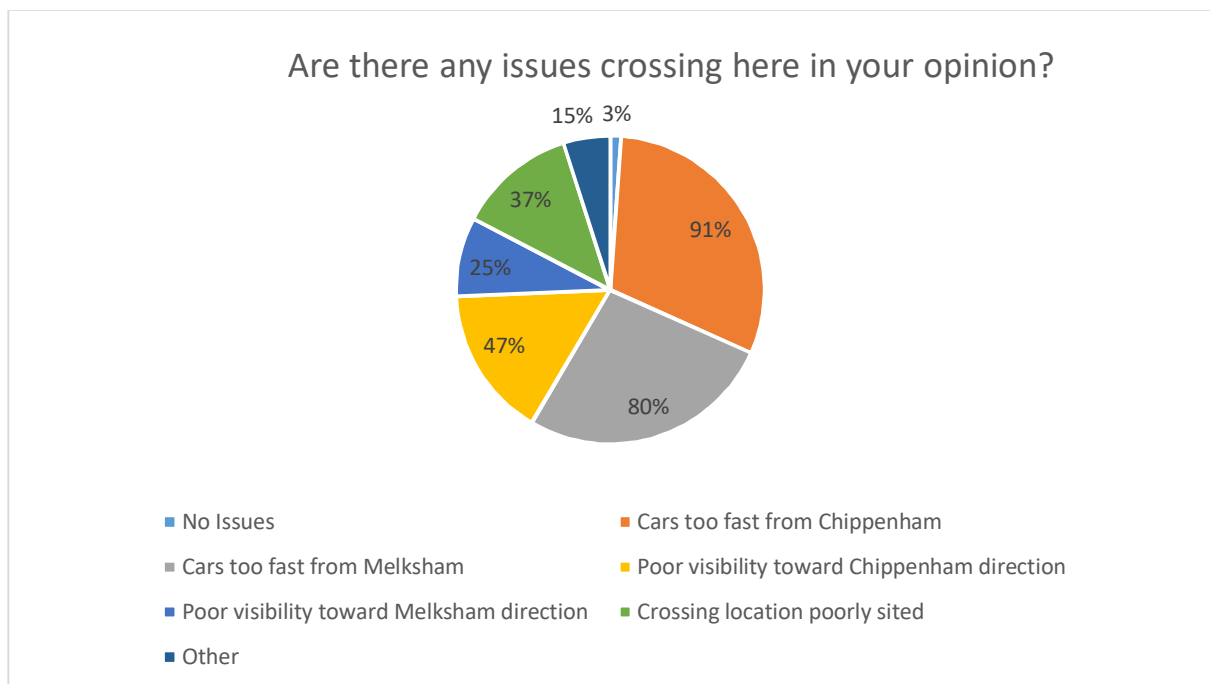
## How often do you use the crossing?

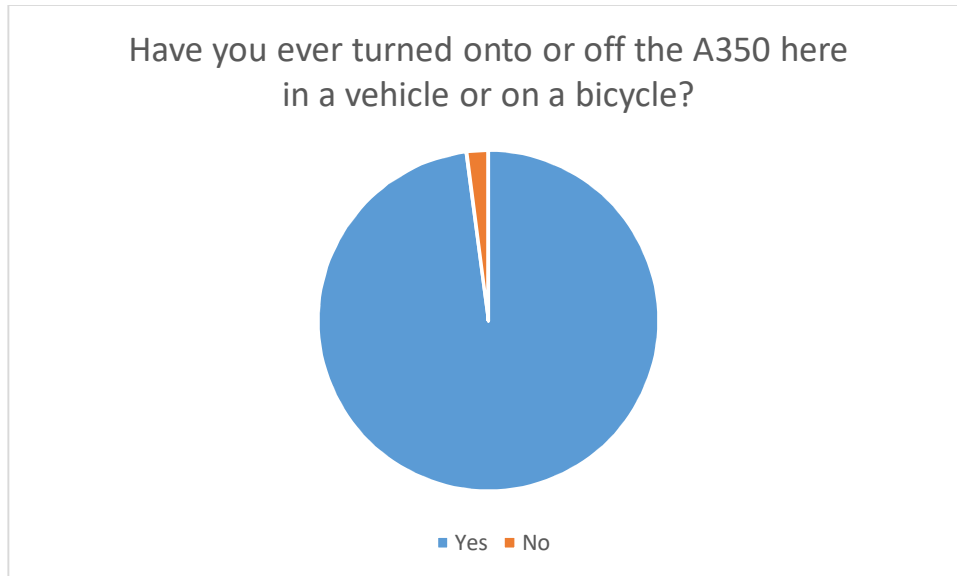


## Sample Responder Comments on Crossing the A350 at Notton

- Very dangerous road junction to cross with a bicycle
- Feels like s a racetrack.
- You need to consider horse riders. This crossing is used by many.
- With a young family in Notton, it's an extreme safety concern. The speed of cars makes crossing hazardous
- I have seen an elderly couple trying to cross here and having to run because cars refuse to slow down
- Cars from Melksham turning left into Notton pose further risk as you have to stand in the slip lane to cross
- There needs to be a 50mph limit in both directions, double white lines and a refuge in the centre of the road.

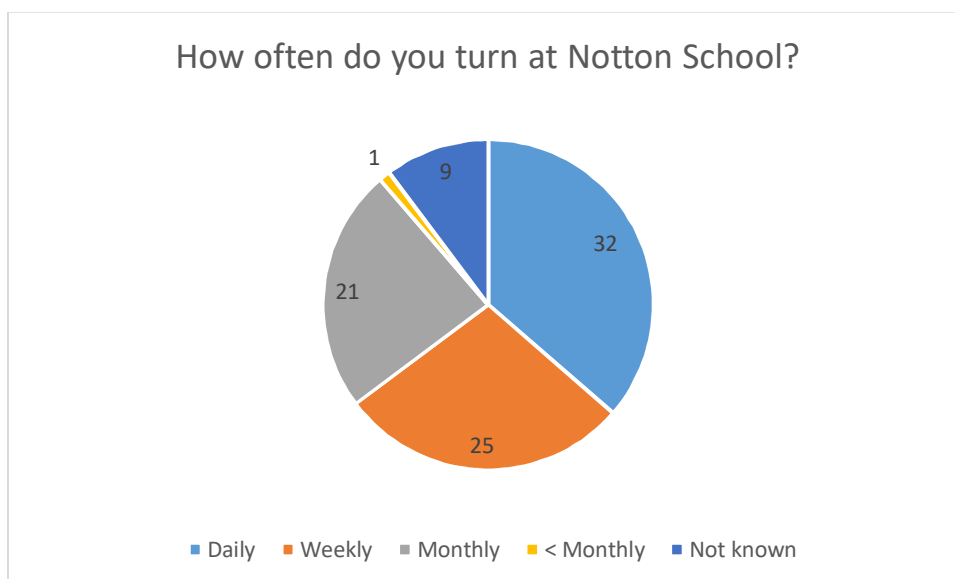
## Motorists using Notton junction on A350

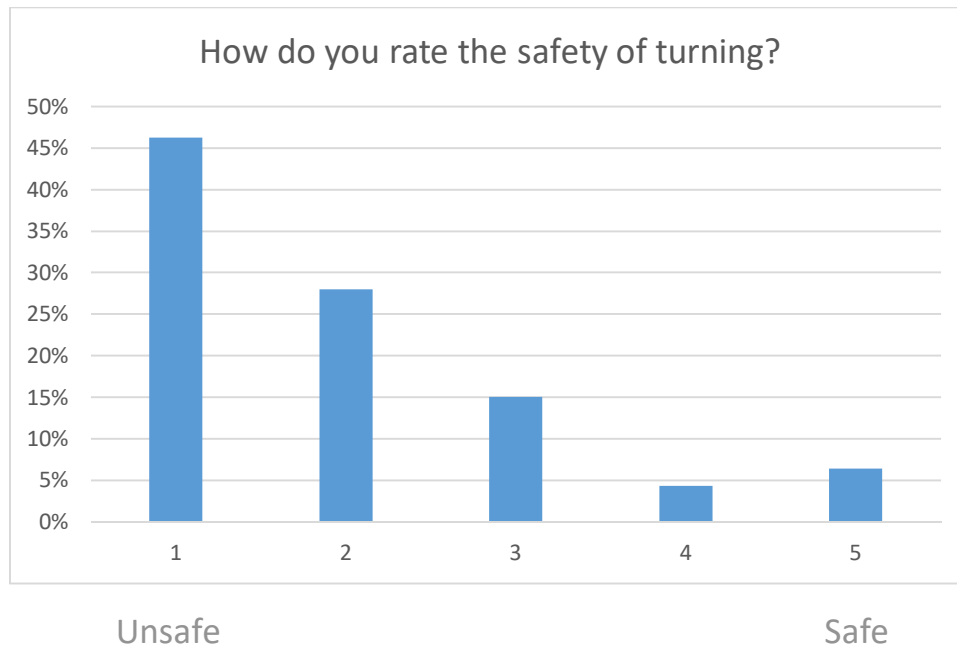

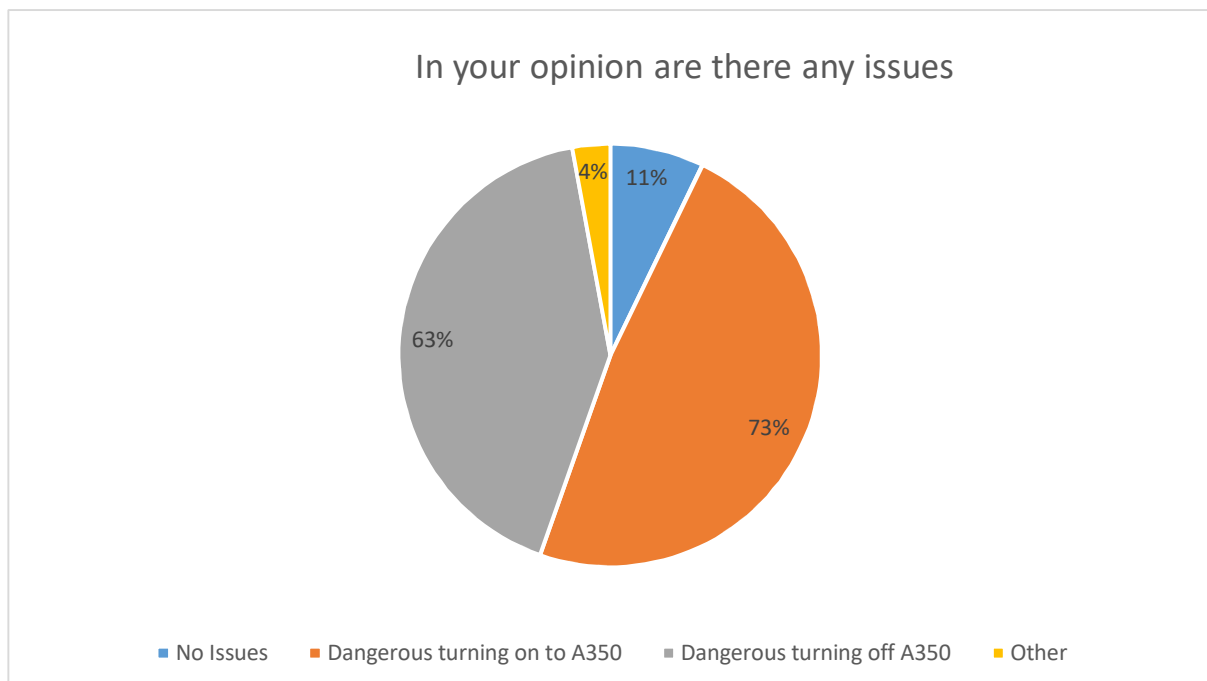

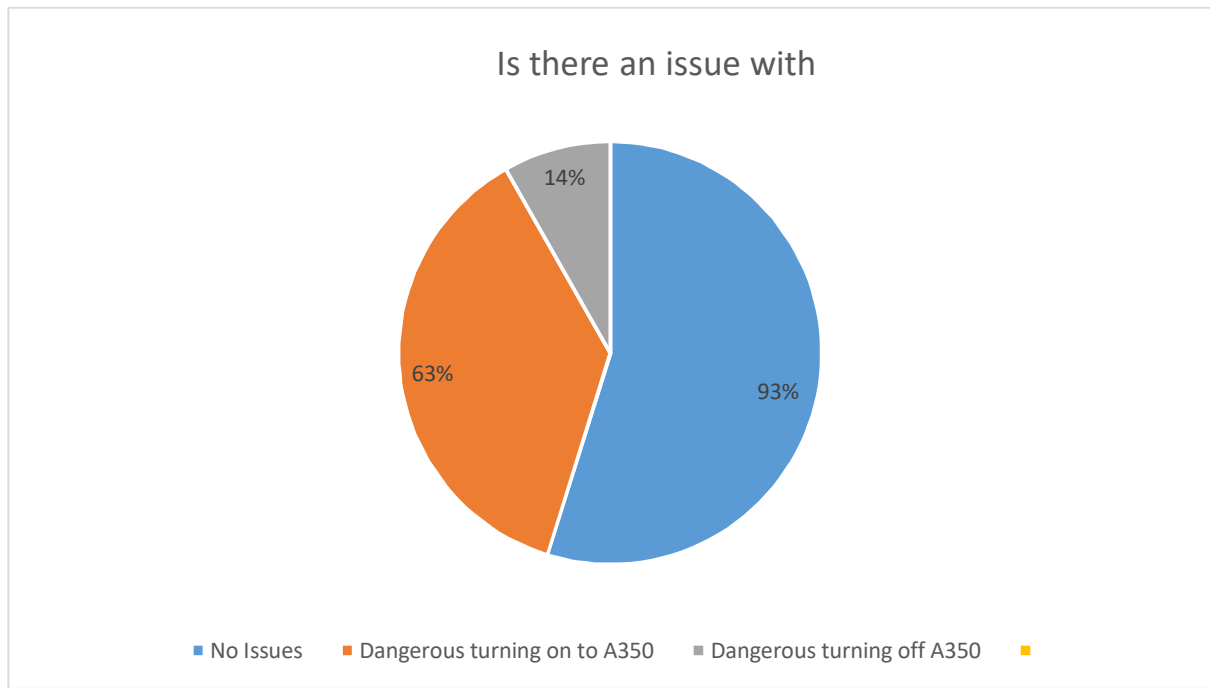
## Issues Using the Junction

## Sample Responder Comments from Motorists using the A350 at Notton

- Safer to drive up through Notton and join A350 at Whitehall Garden Centre junction.
- I used to work at the school and could hear on a daily basis horns being blown where a vehicle had pulled out in front of a vehicle traveling too fast.
- Speed needs reducing all along this section of road from Showell to Beanacre
- Gaps in traffic make northbound access possible with high acceleration to get up to speed.
- It's worrying thinking what might plough into the back of you whilst waiting to turn off the A350
- It is never comfortable waiting in the turn lane with vehicles approaching at speed over the hill, I am especially nervous with children in the car
- Overtaken by lorry whilst waiting to turn off A350
