Creation of new access point onto the A350 - Field west of A350 adjacent to Showell Farm employment site, Showell, Chippenham

The existing access to the field is located directly opposite the location of the approved roundabout that is to serve the SouthPoint Business Park (formerly Showell Farm). Maintaining the access in the current position would not allow for safe access once the roundabout is in place. The application therefore proposes to relocate the field access to a position further to the south east.

The application states the normal hours the premises will be open to the public will be 09.00 - 17.00, except when there are events as listed above in which case they will be open until 23.00hrs.
